DESCRIPTION: The Habilitation Aide is responsible to provide one on one support to an individual in a community based setting.

SPECIFIC JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Works with individuals providing emotional support, guidance in community environments including home and work.
- Maintains required OPWDD recordkeeping.
- Provides transportation for individuals to attend community/recreational activities.
- Provides instruction in basic home making skills, such as simple meal preparation, setting the table, household chores, laundry tasks, wardrobe organization and caring for the pets.
- Assist with community integration.
- Create opportunities for and facilitate peer socialization.
- Attend bi annual and annual meetings.
- Participate in program planning for individual developing goals and objectives for respective habilitation plan
- Develop methods for evaluating progress toward meeting those goals.
- Attend all program and agency staff meeting and required training.

OUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Candidates for this position will have: the ability to demonstrate, and provide examples of continuous personal development and improvement; an individual focused attitude; excellent communication skills (verbal and written); problem solving skills, strong organizational skills and the ability to effectively manage multiple tasks/projects. *Must be SCIP certified or have the ability to be certified and maintain annual SCIP certification.*
