Adult Programs and Services News

All of Holy Childhood's adult program areas here at the agency now have Smartboards in their rooms thanks to generous donations received at our 75th Holy Childhood Anniversary Gala celebration last summer. This valuable technology allows for a multitude of increased on-site activities including the popular, "Sweating to the Oldies" video series which the Senior Day Habilitation Program adults have been thoroughly enjoying. (A Smartboard is an interactive tool that allows images from a computer screen to be displayed onto a large board using a digital projector. Adults can also "interact" with images directly on the screen using a tool or a finger.) Each classroom in our School Program also has Smartboard technology.

The Holy Childhood Community-Based Prevocational Volunteer Group continues to volunteer weekly at the Shore Foundation performing such tasks as wrapping old batteries together, dismantling computer components, old phones, and other computer/tech related items, breaking down & recycling boxes, sweeping the warehouse with magnet brooms and regular brooms, and destroying hard drives. The Group will also begin their volunteer schedule at the Greece Ridge Mall Farmer's Market this month, staffing the Special Touch Bakery booth through September.
